



Example Diets for Cats...

Each breed of dog or cat has its own unique set of nutritional requirements.

Breed Type	Weight of Cat	Amount of Food
Small	2-3kg	50-75g raw meat and chicken wings 1-2 times per week PetArk Daily 2g per day
Medium	4kg	75-100g raw meat and chicken wings 1-2 times per week PetArk Daily 2g per day
Large	5kg	100-125g raw meat and chicken wings 1-2 times per week PetArk Daily 2.5g per day

Give your cat some liver and kidney from time to time
